- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date in the event a dog is disqualified, excused by a judge or club, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- · Refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date only if runs can be filled from the Wait List.
- Any exhibitor, whose dog entered in this trial came into season, or has been restricted from agility by their vet may obtain a partial refund of their entry fees, less \$4.00 per run. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim before judging commences the morning of the trial.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks.
- It's recommended to bring your own chairs and water for your dogs.
- All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) or children engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of fees will be made.
- . No Food, Toys, Balls or similar items may be used within TEN (10) feet of the entrance and exit of the rings and the perimeter.
- All dogs must be kept on lead or in pens or crates when not competing in the ring. No dogs may be tied to chairs, fences, cars, trees, etc.
- Dogs not entered in the trial will be allowed on the trial site, provided they remain in the control of their owner/handler. If they prove to be disruptive, they will be asked to leave the building.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial.
- ➤ Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with <u>CPE</u> prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day of Show entries. Registrations are only processed online at <u>Member Services</u>. CPE ID numbers are emailed after they are processed.
- ➤ Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run, and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½" of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may not be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket the leash must be out of sight.
- > Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time NT.

Declared Training In The Ring

If allowed by the Host Club, and a handler decides they may want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

➤ Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring. See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items are not considered training in the ring:

- Dog grabbing its leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4-paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- > Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring (except as noted above for TIR). Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance (except as noted above for TIR). Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5-fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
