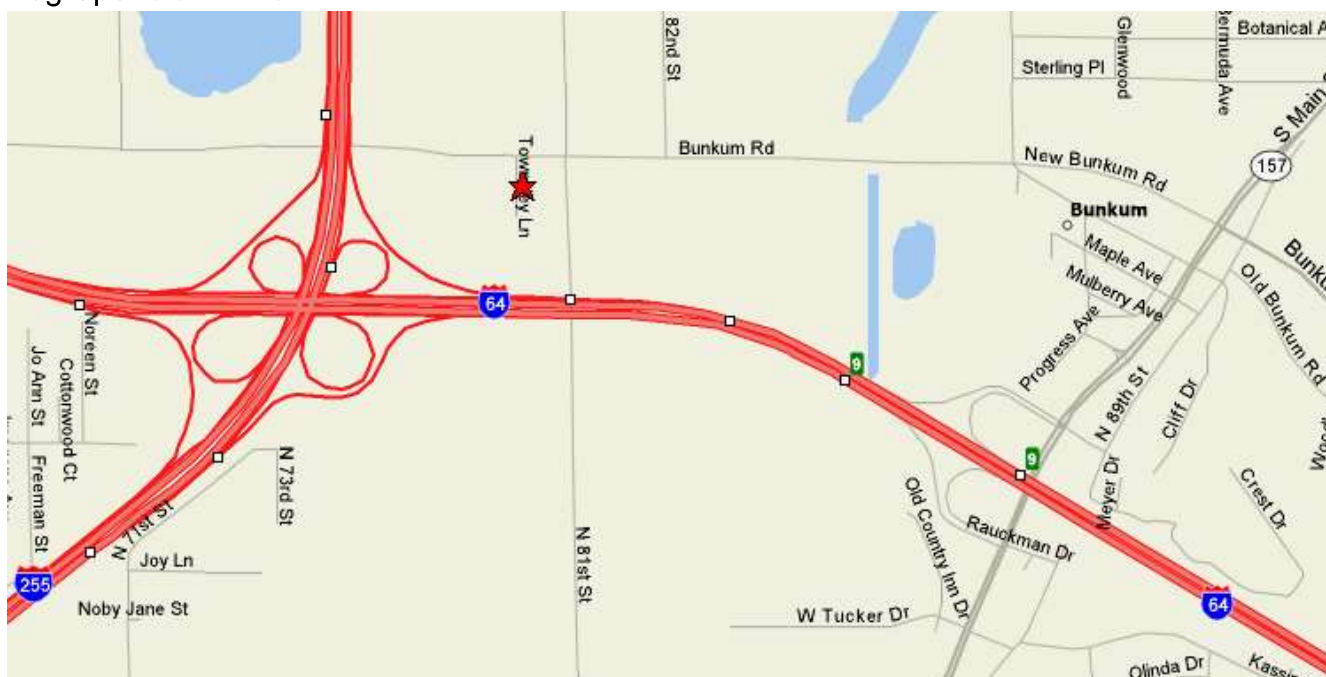

DIRECTIONS

Take I-64 West (from Eastern Illinois) or I-64 East (from St. Louis) to IL-157 N exit 9 (Caseyville/Centreville). Turn North on IL-157 N and go 0.3 miles. Turn left at New Bunkum Road and go 0.4 miles, continuing on Bunkum Road an additional 0.8 miles. Turn left at Townsley Lane to Dog Sports at Kim's.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or

repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Obstacle Familiarization - Obstacle familiarization will be Saturday, and Sunday mornings 8:00AM prior to the judges briefing for dogs and handlers

Warm-ups: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Only dogs entered in the trial may use warm up area. This should be on lead unless dog is under complete control of the handler.

Show site – Site is indoors on stall matting in an area of 5400 sq ft with a ring of 60' X 60'. The contact equipment is rubberized and adheres to TDAA specifications.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs 17" and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Fast-Track dogs **are not** eligible for awards in classes through which they Fast-Track. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered. Title ribbons will also be available. GSLAC will give a special award to any dog having a perfect weekend. The dog must be entered in, and qualify in, all runs during the weekend.

Obstacles

The following is a list of obstacles to be used: (All TDAA size):

- A-frame (6'8" sides)
- Weave Poles (20" centers)
- Table (36" sides)
- Dog-walk (8' planks / slatted)
- Tire Jump (16")
- Single and Winged Jumps
- Teeter (8' plank)

Fall Fun Run/2022 Petit Prix

The Fall Fun Run is a part of this trial. When you register, please indicate whether you wish to compete in the Fall Fun Run so we have an accurate understanding of the participants and can prepare the runs and the trial results correctly. It is not necessary to compete in the Fall Fun Run if you do not wish to do so. All qualifying runs, regardless of whether you are competing in the Fall Fun Run will count toward regular TDAA titles.

The Fall Fun Run will run Superior Standard courses and Games III. You need NOT be in this level to participate.

Announcement:

In 2022 the TDAA Petit Prix will be presented by Cloud Nine Training School for Dogs in Maple Grove, Minnesota on July 28th-31st. Kim and Dennis Vogel are our gracious hosts for this event.

Class Information

Standard Class

- **Beginner Agility** - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Beginner Agility. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- **Intermediate Agility** - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Intermediate Agility. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- **Superior Agility** - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

- **Games I** - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Games I. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- **Games II** - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Games II. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- **Games III** - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Game Briefings

Call – Direct – Send: Briefing

In *Call, Direct & Send* the dog and handler team are challenged to solve three distance riddles on a numbered course. The three distance challenges that give the game its name include: a *Call* over one to three obstacles; a *Direct* or mid-course distance challenge of two to five obstacles; and a *Send* over two to three obstacles to close out the game.

In *Call, Direct & Send*, boundaries are drawn to indicate an area into which the handler may not advance while the dog performs obstacles at a distance. Otherwise, the dog should follow the numbers.

For each distance challenge successfully completed the dog earns 10 points. The scoring basis for this game is Time+Faults-Bonus.

Call – The *Call* is a lead-off at the start line, requiring the handler to call the dog over the opening obstacles. In the *Call* the dog is placed on a *Stay* at the beginning of the course while the handler leads out to a point on the course designated by the judge. The handler must then call the dog over the initial obstacles and continue on course.

Direct – The *Direct* is a mid-course gamble sequence in which the dog will be required to work at a distance from his handler. The handler must direct the dog over the sequence of obstacles without crossing a containment line indicated by the judge and continue on course.

Send – The *Send* is the final gamble challenge. The handler sends the dog to perform the finishing obstacles while working at a distance from the dog in an area designated by the judge.

Rekoons: Briefing

The objective of Rekoons is to score as many points as possible in the time allotted. Rekoons is the game Snooker played in reverse; and is played as a two-part game:

1. **Numbered Sequence:** A numbered sequence must be attempted. The numbered sequence is taken in reverse; first the #7 obstacle, then the #6, and so on, until the dog reaches the #2 obstacle. If the dog faults an obstacle in the numbered sequence he must be directed to begin the second part point accumulation. **Note:** A dog going on to another obstacle in the opening after having faulted an obstacle, will earn judge's whistle, and end of game. Listen closely for the judge calling "Fault!" The Numbered Sequence will be judged using performance faults for the Superior class; (that means, refusals on contact obstacles, for example).

2. **Point Accumulation:** The point accumulation period begins after the dog has completed the #2 obstacle in the opening *or* after having faulted. Points are earned by the completion of a red hurdle and *only* one scoring obstacle of the handler's choice. Each red hurdle can be used only once; and the associated scoring obstacle only if the red hurdle is not faulted. Point values for each individual obstacles performed without fault are as they are numbered for the opening sequence. Refusals and runouts are not faulted. Three or four of red hurdles may be taken. At least three are required. During point accumulation the judge's whistle will indicate the end of scoring. Scoring ends when any of the following occurs:

A red hurdle is repeated

The dog takes more than one scoring obstacle after taking a red hurdle

The dog takes a scoring obstacle after faulting the red hurdle

Scoring and Qualifying

All scoring stops at end of SCT and handler must cross the finish line to stop time. Rekoons is scored points, then time. Time is a tie-breaker only. High points wins. The qualifying run is 37 points.

Big dogs have 45 seconds; small dogs have 50 seconds

Full House: Briefing

The object of Full House is to successfully accumulate required points, and before time expires, gather the elements of the Full House

Three of a Kind – 3 single bar jumps

Twosome – 2 "circles" [tunnel or tire]

Joker – 1 contact or weaves

All obstacles may be performed only twice for points. Back to back performance is allowed.

The timekeeper will signal the end of the point-accumulation period. At the expiration of time, the team has up to 5 seconds to stop the clock by going to the table or crossing the finish line.

Any delay in heading for the finish line or attempting to perform any obstacle on the way to the finish line will result in the loss of the last point value earned. The team will not lose the last point value earned if the dog takes an obstacle without handler direction

Point accumulation time differs by jump height:

4,8,12 whistle 35 seconds, total game time 40 seconds

16, whistle at 30 seconds total game time 35 seconds.

Scoring: 1-3-5 system with the table stopping the clock

Colors: Briefing

Colors is a sequencing game. The handler has a choice of running any one of three short courses that are woven together on the field.

Scoring: Colors is scored Faults, Then Time.

Jumpers: Briefing

Jumpers courses consist only of jumpers and tunnels as set by the judge. Off courses and knocked bars are always faulted.

Scoring: Jumpers is usually scored faults then time.

Our Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers

ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENTS BY TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in TDAA.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles. No training in the ring.

Disabled Handlers

A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

HOW THE FAST TRACK MOVE-UP PROGRAM WORKS

This may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificate for each dog.** Submit \$8.00 for each dog’s move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. This Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial, even if it was paid for a previous trial.

Entries

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms: one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the signed TDAA agreement attached are NOT acceptable.

Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. By its very nature TDAA is small: small dogs, small equipment, small trials, and small number of handlers. We need all hands to make a small trial work. Please volunteer to work during classes you are not running in. We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through. We want everyone to have a pleasant experience and at the same time helping to make the trial run smoothly. There will be sign-up sheets posted in the crating room.
