

#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.

- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

**Obstacle Familiarization** - Obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday mornings 15 minutes prior to the judges briefing for dogs and handlers who did not previously run in the weekend and for Beginner/Level 1 dogs.

**Warm-ups**: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Only dogs entered in the trial may use warm up area. This should be on lead unless dog is under complete control of the handler.

**Show site** – Site is indoors on stall matting in an area of 5400 sq ft with a ring of 60' X 60'. The contact equipment is rubberized and adheres to TDAA specifications.

**Eligibility** - this trial is open to all dogs 17" and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

**Move-Ups** - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered. Title ribbons will also be available. GSLAC will give a special award to any dog having a perfect weekend. The dog must be entered in, and qualify in, all runs during the weekend.

# **Obstacles**

The following is a list of obstacles to be used: (All TDAA size):

- A-frame (6'8" sides)
- Weave Poles (20" centers)
- Table (36" sides)
- Dog-walk (8' planks / slatted)

- Tire Jump (16")
- Single and Winged Jumps
- Teeter (8' plank)

### **Class Information**

# **Standard Class**

- Beginner Agility All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher
  titles from other organizations may fast track through Beginner Agility. An eligible dog may
  move up after one qualifying score.
- Intermediate Agility Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dog's with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Intermediate Agility. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- **Superior Agility** Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

# **Games Classes**

- Games I All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs with higher titles
  from other organizations may fast track through Games I. An eligible dog may move up
  after one qualifying score.
- **Games II** Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class. Dogs with higher titles from other organizations may fast track through Games II. An eligible dog may move up after one qualifying score.
- Games III Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

# **Rabbit Express**

**Briefing** — The objective of Rabbit Express is to summon the inner speed in every dog, while at the same time creating an opportunity for the dog that approaches life from the point of view of the tortoise to prevail. Rabbit Express is a numbered course that dogs will need to run like the proverbial rabbit. The goal is to negotiate the Rabbit Express sequence as quickly as possible. However, there is a twist, (of course!) that the wise tortoise may take advantage of. Somewhere along the course three Rabbit Holes will be hidden. The reckless rabbit who falls into the hole must navigate a detour sequence to dig itself out and get back on the Rabbit Express. That could be just the chance the Tortoise needs to pass right by! No refusal faults shall be called, however all obstacles must be performed, else a 20 point failure to perform fault shall be assessed.

Scoring Rabbit Express is scored Time, Plus Faults. The judge will establish course time for each level. SCT shall be calculated without taking into account any detour sequence.

#### In and Out

**Briefing:** The course is divided into three different segments. The "inner" loop, the "in and out" loop and the "outer" loop. The dog must start with the "inner" loop, move to the in & out loop and finish with the outer loop. If a fault occurs during a loop, the dog must immediately restart from the first obstacle in that loop. The loop is repeated until completed without fault. Then the dog must start the next loop. The judge will call out "fault" when a dog has faulted an obstacle. The game is scored under TDAA rules.

Faults are: Dropping a jump bar, missing a contact, or going off course. Refusals are not faulted. The standard course time shall be established by the judge. The timekeeper will blow a whistle at the end of course time. If the dog has not completed the course, he must be directed to the finish line to stop time. Each obstacle has an assigned point value.

the point system is:

• 1 point for jumps

- 3 points for tunnels and the tire
- 5 points for contact obstacles and weave poles.

If the dog completes the entire course before time runs out, the difference between the dog's time and the course time becomes bonus points added to the score. All times are rounded up to the next second.

**Scoring** In and Out is scored Points, Then Time. The dog with the most points wins. Time is a tiebreaker only.

### **Just In Time**

**Briefing**: The objective of this game is to accumulate (the most) points by performance of obstacles and subsequently arrive at the table as close as possible to the expiration of time. Just In Time is identical to the point-accumulation period of a Gamblers class. This is a "dog's-choice" game. The dog can perform obstacles in the order and direction of his choosing (hopefully, with some collaboration from the handler). Obstacles can be performed only twice for points. Back-to-back performance are permitted

Scoring: Just in Time is scored Points, Then Time.

The points system is:

- Jumps are worth 1 point
- Tunnels and the short set of weave poles are worth 3 points
- The dogwalk and teeter are worth 5 points.

Unproductive loitering near the table is not permitted and shall result in loss of time bonus points. The dog will earn a time bonus for getting to the finish line after the end of the 60/65- second point-accumulation period.

- Less than 2 seconds earns 30 time bonus points
- Less than 4 seconds earns 20 time bonus points
- Less than 6 seconds earns 10 time bonus points

To qualify the dog must earn:

- Games I = 31 points
- Games II = 41 points
- Games III = 51 points

#### **Boomerang**

Boomerang is a game where the dog must perform obstacles to accumulate points. Once the dog goes through the red tunnel if he returns on the same path to the start of that sequence, he will receive a bonus for a successful "Boomerang Throw".

The game starts when the dog crosses the start line. The team will receive points for each obstacle taken without fault in a numbered sequence (a Boomerang Throw), 1 for jumps, 3 for tunnels and tire, and 5 for contacts. If an obstacle is faulted the team will receive no points for that obstacle and will negate a successful Throw. Obstacles taken out of order (off-course obstacles) will receive no points and will negate a successful Throw. Refusals will not be called. Jumps with dropped bars are out of play for the rest of the game and will negate the Bonus for the current Throw and the bonus for that Throw if taken again. If the team does not complete a Throw, the next Throw starts when the dog takes the first jump (jump labeled 1) of the same or another Throw.

#### **Bonus**

The team will receive a bonus for the successful completion of a "Boomerang Throw" sequence. The "Boomerang Throws" on the course are the numbered sequences. The first Throw will start at the first number one obstacle the dog takes in the correct direction. A successful Boomerang Throw is a sequence that includes the red tunnel performance taken once at the end of a sequence. Once the red tunnel is taken the sequence to that point must be repeated in reverse to end at the jump where it started. A bonus of one point for each obstacle in the Boomerang Throw sequence including the red tunnel will be awarded for a successful throw. Once a Boomerang Throw is complete (i.e., the dog takes the first jump of the sequence a second time), successfully or not, a new throw is started when the dog takes the next obstacle labeled one in the correct direction. The judge will call out "Bonus" to indicate a successful Boomerang Throw and the beginning of the next Throw, or "Throw" to indicate the start of the next Throw.

Any off course, or faulted obstacle during a Throw will negate the bonus.

An additional bonus of 40 points can be received if the dog completes each of the Throws once. Each Boomerang Throw can be taken twice for points.

Time begins when the dog crosses the start line. Point accumulation ends when the timekeeper calls time. Total game time ends when the dog touches the table. The table is live once time starts.

# **Scoring**

Points plus Bonus then time (ER8).

**QCT** 50 seconds for tall dogs and 55 seconds for small dogs.

# Qualifying

50 points

Our Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

#### **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division other than their measured division will be scored in their measured jump height division. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers

**ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD** must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENTS BY TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in TDAA.

# For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles. No training in the ring.

# **Disabled Handlers**

A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

#### **Entries**

# Closing Date is November 3, 2022

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms: one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the signed TDAA agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

# **VOLUNTEER SIGN UP**

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. By its very nature TDAA is small: small dogs, small equipment, small trials, and small number of handlers. We need all hands to make a small trial work. Please volunteer to work during classes you are not running in. We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through.
