NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil
 disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause
 beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an
 excusal from the ring.

Obstacle Familiarization - Obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday mornings 15 minutes prior to the judges briefing for dogs and handlers who did not previously run in the weekend and for Beginner/Level 1 dogs.

Warm-ups: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Only dogs entered in the trial may use warm up area. This should be on lead unless dog is under complete control of the handler.

Show site – Site is indoors on stall matting in an area of 5400 sq ft with a ring of 60' X 60'. The contact equipment is rubberized and adheres to TDAA specifications.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs 17" and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered. Title ribbons will also be available. GSLAC will give a special award to any dog having a perfect weekend. The dog must be entered in, and qualify in, all runs during the weekend.

Obstacles

The following is a list of obstacles to be used: (All TDAA size):

- A-frame (6'8" sides)
- Weave Poles (20" centers)
- Table (36" sides)
- Dog-walk (8' planks / slatted)

- Tire Jump (16")
- Single and Winged Jumps
- Teeter (8' plank)

Class Information

Standard Class

- Beginner Agility All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class
- Intermediate Agility Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- Superior Agility Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

- **Games I** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- **Games II** Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- **Games III** Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Touch N Go

Briefing — This game consists of contact obstacles and tunnels only. The handler must direct the dog to perform the obstacles in the order specified by the judge. Refusals are not faulted, and there are no jump bars to drop. All the handler has to worry about is the dog touching the contacts and staying on course.

Scoring – Touch N Go is scored faults, then time. The dog with the fewest faults will win. Time is a tiebreaker only

Failure to complete – 20 faults

Running the wrong course – 10 faults

Missed safety zone (descent only) – 10 faults

Body blocking – 10 faults

Time faults – the dog will be assessed time faults for each second or fraction of a second that it exceeds the standard course time. ER12

Tunnel Snookers

Briefing: Tunnel Snooker is a two-part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The first is dog's choice in which the dog earns the right to score three 'colored' obstacles by doing a designated tunnel before each. The second part is a simple sequence. Tunnel Snooker is scored Points, then time. ER2

April's Fool

Briefing: The April's Fool course is essentially a standard run with a twist. Handlers direct their dogs through the course in the order and direction specified by the judge's numbering of the course. Before each dog and handler team run, however, they will be required to turn their backs to the course. A runner will mark two obstacles on the course with an "APRIL'S FOOD" sign. Marked obstacles must be **skipped** during the run. After the course is marked, the dog and handler team must immediately run the course. A dog taking an obstacle marked April's Food will incur an off-course penalty of 5 faults. When the next handler/dog team is up to run, another person is re-mark

the course, omitting two obstacles. So, the course is basically different each run and offers a good chance to work on call-offs.

Scoring – April's Fool is scored time plus faults. The dog with the lowest score wins.

Dropped bars, off-course, missed contacts – 5 faults

Failure to perform – 20 faults

Refusals – not faulted

Missed weave poles – not faulted, but the performance must be corrected or the dog earns a failure to perform.

Box Game

Briefing – Like a typical Jumpers course, the dog is required to perform the course in the order and direction specified by the judge.

Once the dog clears hurdle #1, the handler must stay within a containment area specified by the judge until the dog completes the course. A 5 point fault is assessed for each time the handler leaves the containment area before the dog completes the course.

A bonus of 5 points is given to the team for each successful send. This might off-set any failed sends. **Scoring** – The Box Game is scored Time, Plus Faults.

Our Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in any height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be scored with dogs of their measured height. TDAA height divisions are:

- 2" jump height: for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers

ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD must be measured prior to the first day of competing at this trial. Arrive early enough to accommodate measuring.

TWO MEASUREMENTS BY TDAA JUDGES are needed to show a dog in TDAA.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles. No training in the ring.

Disabled Handlers

A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

Entries

Closing Date is March 2, 2023

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms: one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the signed TDAA agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

Volunteers are the backbone of any agility trial. By its very nature TDAA is small: small dogs, small equipment, small trials, and small number of handlers. We need all hands to make a small trial work. Please volunteer to work during classes you are not running in. We will make sure you get adequate time to warm up your dog and do your walk-through. We want everyone to have a pleasant experience and at the same time helping to make the trial run smoothly

Instructions

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of the new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to TDAA.
